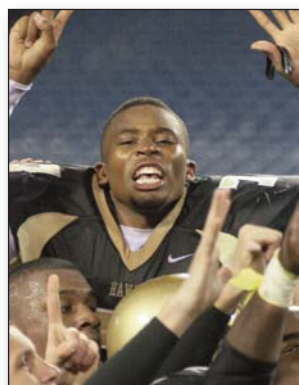
5 Jantzi Leaves NT

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Sciandra Honored for Title Win

Cardinal O'Hara coach Angelo Sciandra has been named Buffalo Bills Coach of the Week after the Hawks beat St. Mary's 25-7 to win the Msgr. Martin Association League A championship in Ralph Wilson Stadium.

It was the 6th straight Msgr. Martin title for O'Hara.

"It never gets boring," Sciandra said. "It's exciting for the kids and it's exciting for me and the coaches."

Sciandra says he was unsure of his team when the season started.

"I wasn't sure how we would do," he said. "We were a very young team this year. But the offensive line began to play better and we went on a 5-game winning streak."

O'Hara finished 7-4 this season despite playing one of the toughest schedules in Western New York. The Hawks played large-school St. Francis, St. Joe's and Canisius as well as Ohio

powerhouse Steubenville.

"We had a tough stretch where we lost three in a row," Sciandra said. "We lost to St. Joe's, St. Francis and Steubenville but the kids rebounded."

O'Hara has played at Steubenville for three straight seasons.

"I think it's a great experience for the kids," he said. "It's a different game in Ohio. It's a great atmosphere and they get to spend a couple of nights in a hotel as a team."

Sciandra felt confident during the week leading up to the title game against St. Mary's.

"These kids had one of the best week's of practices I have ever seen," Sciandra said. "I have never had a team so ready to play a game. A lot of our kids played their best game of the year, which was good to see."

Sciandra just finished his tenth season as the coach at Cardinal O'Hara.

He played defensive back for Kenmore West and graduated in 1973.

He attended the University at Buffalo but did not play football. He earned his undergraduate and Master's

Degrees at UB.

After graduating from UB, Sciandra landed his first coaching job at Cheektowaga High School.

"Tom Goddard hired me in 1979 at Cheektowaga," Sciandra said. "He made me the head JV coach right out of college."

Sciandra took over the varsity head coaching job at St. Mary's in 1986 and stayed there until 1999.

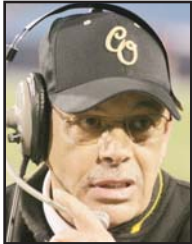
"I was there for 16 years," Sciandra said, "and we beat some pretty good Turner-Carroll teams."

St. Mary's won Msgr. Martin titles in 1993 and 1995 under Sciandra.

Sciandra now has a career won-lost record of 70-31 and has had several top players.

Kevin Burns (St. Mary's) and Reggie Garner (O'Hara) were finalists for the Connolly Cup. Burns played college football at the Penn. Garner is currently playing at Walsh University, an NAIA school in Ohio.

Also, Ron Keels (O'Hara) played at Gannon University and later for the Ottawa Roughriders in the CFL.

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Jantzi gone... Goddard next?

At the end of every football season, there are coaching changes.

Two changes will drastically alter the

Last night, in a story first reported in the Tonawanda News, it was learned that North Tonawanda coach Eric Jantzi had announced his resignation from the top of the NT program.

Also, rumors continued to swirl that Clarence coach Tom Goddard, who led the Red Devils to the Section 6 Class AA title this fall, would retire from teaching and coaching at the end of the school year.

Goddard refused to confirm the rumors that he would step down as Clarence coach.

"Thirty-eight years is a long time," Goddard said. "I still enjoy working with young men and seeing the results of a lot of work. The kids are just great."

Clarence finished 10-1 this season and beat Orchard Park in Ralph Wilson Stadium when Stephen Hughes kicked a 37-yard field goal on the last play of the game.

The Devils lost a 42-34 shootout to Section 5's Rush-Henrietta in the Far West Regional game.

Our kids never quit," Goddard said. "We were down 21-0 and came back and we were down 35-14 at the half and made it a ball game. These kids just refused to quit."

Goddard said that this may have been his most enjoyable season.

"The way the kids came together as a team from Day 1 was awesome," he said. "They enjoyed being together in practice and on the sidelines. It was fun and enjoyable for all of us."

Goddard started coaching in 1972 when he landed an assistant varsity job at Pembroke High School.

In 1980 he was hired as the head coach at Cheektowaga Central and stayed there until 1985.

In 1986 Goddard was hired as a Phys Ed teacher at Clarence, his alma mater. He was an assistant on staff until 1993, when he was hired as the head coach.

He was the head coach at Clarence for the past 18 seasons, leading his team to Ralph Wilson Stadium four

times. He won two Section 6 titles and has a career record of 115-98.

While Goddard's possible retirement would not be a surprise, the announcement that Jantzi would leave North Tonawanda was shocking.

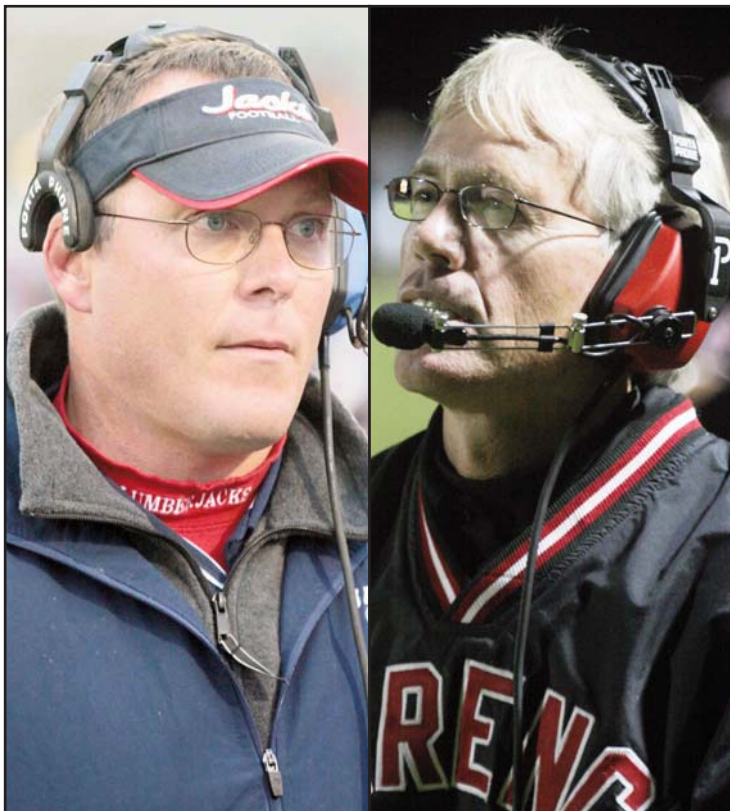

He has been at the front of the North Tonawanda program for 16 seasons.

Jantzi says that he is resigning because his family is moving to Orchard Park.

"We sold our house and we are moving closer to our family in Orchard Park," he said. "I am here every day, over the breaks, in the summer and it's just too far to drive. I wouldn't be able to do it right. I didn't want to do something half-assed."

Jantzi says that he agonized over the decision.

"It was a really tough decision," he said. "I've been thinking about it for a while."

Jantzi said that the responsibilities of being a head coach had become too much with the added travel time.

"It's not just practice," Jantzi said. "It's making videos. It's hard to

make the game-day programs. It's everything. I came home the other night and my son wanted to play with me. I couldn't because I had to make an end-of-the-year video for the banquet."

The distance is just too much for Jantzi to give the same effort as he required of his players.

"I want them here every day to lift weights," Jantzi said. "We do the summer passing leagues and the off-season workouts. I can't ask them to do that if I'm not here myself."

"It was very easy when I could be here in 10 seconds," Jantzi said. "Now it will be an extra 90 minutes a day in commuting time."

Jantzi says that he has no specific plans to coach next season.

"I would like to keep coaching," Jantzi said, "but everything is open and up in the air. I might take an assistant coach somewhere."

Msgr. Martin Association Playoffs

St. Joe's, O'Hara take MMA titles

St. Joe's quarterback Chad Kelly ran eight times for 170 yards and 2 TDs and threw for 191 yards and 4 TDs as St. Joes beat St. Francis 49-20 and won the Msgr. Martin Association title game in Ralph Wilson Stadium.

Senior running back Nick Hall ran 10 times for 103 yards and two second-half touchdowns as St. Joe's claimed the school's first league title since 2006.

Hall finished the season with 1,051 rushing yards and 21 touchdowns. He was also one of WNY's top receivers this season and he finished his career with 4,826 all-purpose yards and 39 TDs.

"Chad and Nick are quite a one-two punch," St. Joe's coach Dennis Gilbert said. "Defenses really have a hard time stopping both of them."

St. Joe's opened up a 21-0 lead and led at the half 28-7.

Kelly ran for TDs of 30, 85 and 5 yards and threw a 15-yard TD pass in the first half.

He scrambled out of trouble and broke through the secondary on the 85-yard run.

"That was an unbelievable play," Gilbert said. "He got out of trouble and was gone."

In the evening's first game, senior Robert Davis rushed for 152 yards and 2 TDs to lead Cardinal O'Hara to the League A title with a 25-7 win over St. Mary's.

It was the Hawk's 6th straight championship-game victory at The Ralph. All of the Hawks wins have come over St. Mary's.

"It never gets boring," O'Hara coach Angelo Sciandra said. "It's exciting for the kids and it's exciting for me and the coaches."

Davis finished the season with just under 1,600 yards rushing and was named to the All-Football Weekly first-team.

"I wish I could come back and play with the guys next year," Davis said after the game. "Three championships in three years."

St. Mary's QB Chad Griffin connected with senior tossed a TD pass to Anthony Bargnesi with less than a minute to play in the half but the Lancers could get no closer.

Rochester Takes Four

Western New York will not have the party at the Carrier Dome that the Buffalo area had during the last two state championship weekends.

Section 6 won four New York State titles in 2008 and again in 2009. Last weekend, Section 5 (Rochester) teams won four of the five far West Regional games.

Fredonia, in the Class C game, defeated Letchworth 18-13 and will carry the Section 6 flag into the New York State semifinals this weekend against General Brown.

Quarterback Shane Smith completed 13 of 17 passes for 2 TDs. He also rushed for 71 yards and had 9 tackles and an interception on defense.

Fredonia coach Bob Ball said that while the community is excited, his team is trying to stay low key.

"The school has been very supportive," Ball said. "The local newspapers and the radio station are following us. But the kids are keeping everything in check. We know that we have unfinished business and we need to take this one week at a time."

This is Fredonia's first trip to the New York State semifinals. The Hillbillies will play General Brown (Section 3) at 12:00 pm Saturday at Rochester's Marina Auto Stadium.

Ball says that he had high hopes when practice started back in August.

Smith was returning from a major knee injury that kept him from playing in 2009.

"We felt we had something special with Shane coming back," Ball said. "We changed from a power offense to the spread because he was coming back. We have 4 to 5 good athletes and I felt the spread is a perfect for what we could do."

Fredonia finished the regular season 6-1 and then beat Cleveland Hill 56-14 in the opening round of the playoffs.

"We started to peak during the Cleve Hill game," Ball said. "It was the first time we really took it to our opponent and we've improved every week since them. We've beat some very good teams."

The rest of the weekend was a washout for Section 6 teams.

Rochester brought teams with enormous

size advantages to All-High Stadium and used it to win the other four contests.

Caledonia-Mumford held off Silver Creek 20-13 in Class D.

In Class B, Hornell defeated Alden 21-14. Hornell is the defending New York State champions in Class B.

Aquinas used a huge size advantage to beat Sweet Home 36-6 in Class A. The loss snapped the Panthers 36-game winning streak. The last team to beat Sweet Home was Aquinas in the 2007 New York State playoffs.

In Class AA Clarence fell behind 21-0 in the first quarter and 35-14 at the half before losing a shootout to Rush-Henrietta 34-28.

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Year of the QB

Joe Licata and Chad Kelly led an incredible season for quarterbacks

There is no doubt that 2010 will go down as the Year of the Quarterback in Western New York.

Never have so many quarterbacks produced so much in the same season. Solid seasons were totally overlooked because of the REALLY great years.

Williamsville South senior Joe Licata passed for 2,573 yards and 34 TDs in 2010 as he led the Billies to a 9-1 record and a spot in the Section 6 Class A title game.

In his three seasons leading the Williamsville South offense, Licata has simply re-written the WNY record book. He owns almost every passing record and will graduate this spring as Western New York's most accomplished QB ever.

Licata set single-game, season and career records for attempts, completions, yards and TDs. The only record he does not own is TD passes in a game (the record is 8, Licata's personal best is seven.)

Licata's career records for TDs (87), completions (408) and yardage (6,671) may stand for a while.

His coach Kraig Kurzanski says that Licata could have posted even bigger numbers.

"We took Joe out when we were winning big," Kurzanski said. "If Joe would have played four quarters his numbers would have been off the charts."

While Kurzanski is sorry to see Licata leave his Williamsville South program, he is confident that Licata will be just as good when he plays for the University at Buffalo next season.

"Joe's been great," Kurzanski said. "He's as humble as he is good. I think he'll do great things for UB. He has a

unique ability and I think he'll be even better with better athletes around him. That's why I'm so excited for him."

Kurzanski says that high school defenses were geared totally to stop his passing game.

"Joe won't see the same coverages at UB that we saw at the high school level," Kurzanski said. "He'll see a lot more one-on-one coverages and he'll be able to get the ball wherever he needs to. I think he'll do very well."

St. Joe's junior Chad Kelly posted an equally amazing season as he became the first player in new York State history to pass for 2,000 yards and rush for 1,000 yards in the same season.

He finished the 2010 campaign with 1,057 yards rushing and 2,159 yards passing in 11 games.

"I knew in the passing leagues last spring that we had something special," St. Joe's coach

Dennis Gilbert said. "Chad has incredible skills. I knew that if we could catch the ball, he could make all the throws. And when he got into trouble he could run."

Kelly had a huge performance in the Msgr. Martin Association title game in Ralph Wilson Stadium. He ran eight times for 170 yards and 2 TDs and threw for 191 yards and 4 TDs as St. Joes beat St. Francis 49-20 and won the league title for the first time since 2006.

Because of the performance that the two QBs put up all season, the Football Weekly has named them Players of the Year.

And, while Licata and Kelly stand out among QBs,

there were a LOT of great seasons by Western New York quarterbacks in 2010.

Alden's Tyler Stoldt threw 22 TD passes and just 2 INTs as he led Alden to the Class B title.

Fredonia's Shane Smith passed for 1,616 yards and 21 TDs and also led his team in rushing with 801 yards. He will lead the Hillbillies into the New York State semifinals this weekend in Rochester against General Brown.

Sweet Home's Jordan Johnson was one of the most exciting running QBs to come along in years as he led the Panthers to a fourth straight Class A title.

Even QBs that won't be named to any All-WNY teams had outstanding seasons. Grand Island's Tom Dzielski passed for 2,067 yards and 19 TDs.

Southwestern's Jake Rauh passed for 1,210 yards and 19 TDs while completing over 70 percent of his passes. Wilson's Joe Parrott passed for 1,593 yards. Lackawanna's Christian Smith tossed 15 TD passes and rushed for 964 yards.

And the list goes on and on and on...

"There's some great quarterbacks out there right now," Gilbert said.

"Travis Eman at Canisius was outstanding. Aaron Ertel from Depew had a great year."

Kurzanski says that part of the reason is the proliferation of the Spread offense.

"I think that the Spread offense has finally reached Western New York," Kurzanski said. "That offense spreads out the defenders and puts the best athletes in space. That's part of the reason that you are seeing all these great numbers being put up by the quarterbacks."

And part of it is simply the fact that the area has some very solid players all coming through the system right now.

Kelly was a four-time National Punt, Pass & Kick champion. Licata is a star in football and basketball. Most of the top QBs in WNY are starts in other sports.

Kelly has another year of high school football left.

"He'll be one of the greatest quarterbacks to ever play in Western New York by the time he's done," Gilbert said. "He loves to compete and he loves to get better. He'll be even better next season."

That may dishearten some of the St. Joe's opponents. It's hard to see how Kelly could be much better than he was in the MMA title game.

"I just felt that the night was going to be special," Kelly said. "I just had a feeling it was going to be a great night."

And, while Kelly has one more season to play, Licata will take his talent to the college in the spring.

WNY fans won't have to travel as Licata will be playing at the University at Buffalo, less than a 10-minute drive from his home in Williamsville.

Licata was initially crushed after losing to Sweet Home in the Class A title game.

"That night it was a huge disappointment," Licata said. "After a few days I realized that we played a great team and Sweet Home did a great job. We played our hearts out and we have no regrets."

He also says that he feels good about where the Williamsville South program stands as he leaves.

"Four years ago, Williamsville South was 2-8," he said. "To go 9-1 just four years later is amazing. I think it speaks volumes about the coaching staff and how much work the players put in. I think, with the coaches we have, Williamsville South will be a good team or many years."

Licata is pleased with all the records he now owns... but not because it reflects on his own talent.

"It's pretty cool to be on top of the leader board," he said. "But what's really nice is to see Williamsville South represented in the record book. I'm proud of where I come from and I'm proud to be a Billygoat."

No Average Joe's

St. Joe's coach Dennis Gilbert is Coach of the Year

St. Joe's coach Dennis Gilbert has been named the Football Weekly's Coach of the Year.

St. Joe's beat St. Francis 49-20 in Ralph Wilson Stadium last weekend to win the Msgr. Martin Association League AA title.

"We continued to progress and improve," Gilbert said. "It was a great effort in all facets of the game. Offense defense and special teams were all strong."

The win also finished an amazing turn-around for the Marauders. After Week 4, St. Joe's stood at 1-3 and had been beaten 49-21 by local rival St. Francis.

"I wasn't discouraged," Gilbert said. "We knew that we weren't that far away. We knew we could move the ball on anybody. We just had to take better care of the football."

Gilbert says that he needed to point his players in a positive direction after the loss to St. Francis.

"We talked right on the field after the game," he said. "We said 'This is where our season starts.' We stayed positive, focused on film and the scouting package for the next game. The kids bought into it."

Seven weeks later, the Marauders had claimed their first league title since 2006. They won 5 of their final 7 games, losing only to Ohio-based powerhouse teams, and defeated arch-rival Canisius twice in that stretch.

"There's no doubt that we were a very different team from Week 1 to Week 10," Gilbert said. "We were very inexperienced team at the start of the season and we matured. The kids gradually got better day-by-day in practice."

Gilbert said that the coaching staff emphasized that

Gilbert said. "I learned a ton from him."

When Gilbert was interviewed for the job, the Marauders had lost to Canisius five straight times. St. Joe's had not played for a Msgr. Martin title in three years.

"I was asked what we needed to do differently," he said. "I said that we needed to get our swagger back. We are St. Joe's. We expect to be the best and nothing else is acceptable. We had lost some of that swagger. We can't expect people to roll over for us but the kids had to have a sense of the pride and tradition that comes with being a student at St. Joe's."

Gilbert played four seasons of football at St. Joe's.

too many players were trying to do too much.

"Our kids truly got the team concept of playing football," Gilbert said. "After Week 4, we got them to believe in each other. They were trying to play outside of themselves. Guys had to start doing their own job and trust that their teammates would theirs."

Gilbert said that this was one of the closest teams he has coached in his career.

"They truly liked each other," Gilbert said. "each one of them had a ton of respect for his teammates, from the superstar to the 40th kid on the roster. "

Gilbert is in his first season as St. Joe's head coach. He was hired in February to take over for longtime coach Bob O'Connor.

Gilbert started at QB for O'Connor in 1983 and 1984.

"I got a full dose of Bob, first as a coach and then as a player,"

After graduating, he joined O'Connor's coaching staff and eventually took over the JV program.

In 18 years with the JV team, Gilbert led the Marauders to more than 100 wins.

"We might go out and lose a game," he said, "but we never got outthit. You have to be physical and you have to be mentally tough. No matter what happens, keep swinging. We might get beat but the other team was going to know who they played."

When he was named as the fifth coach in the program's history, Gilbert says he was initially overwhelmed.

"Tucker Reddington and Bob O'Connor set the bar pretty high at St. Joe's," Gilbert said. "They built a legacy and, even more, they built expectations. Both of them were workaholics who were committed to the program and the kids. They were committed to teaching all the time."

Gilbert's full-time job is as a City of Buffalo Police Officer. He was with the Buffalo Housing Authority for three years before it was shut down in 2005. He took a job working with the New York State Inspector General's Office before joining the Buffalo Police force in 2007.

"I see a lot of bad stuff," he said. "A lot of pain and suffering at times. Seeing blood and death is difficult. But I also get the opportunity to help people that need help and protect people that can't protect themselves."

Before becoming a police officer, Gilbert managed a bar for several years.

"That was kind of like being a cop," he said with a laugh. "It was wild. You learn a lot about people. Unfortunately, you see people at their worst sometimes."

Gilbert says that coaching football is a huge relief from the stress of being a cop.

"I might go from a homicide scene to football practice," he said, "but I'm invigorated because the kids soak up everything. The passion they have for football makes you feel young again."

Gilbert says he feels no different than he did when he was a quarterback for St. Joe's.

"I feel the same before games like I did when I was playing," he said. "The anxiety, anticipation and excitement are all there. Coaching is a great outlet for anyone who wants to stay involved with the game."

Gilbert has been married to his wife Kim for 16 years. His son, Dennis Jr., was born on a day that Gilbert's JV team was playing against Canisius.

"My sister-in-law came down to the field and said that mom was taking Kim to the hospital," he said. "I told her, 'OK, I'll be there when the game is over.' I made it with two hours to spare."

Gilbert says he is deeply satisfied with his first season at the helm of the St. Joe's program... and not because of the championship.

"We had a heck of a season," Gilbert said. "There were schools that had better years, but I think our kids learned a ton of life lessons. How to work with each other for a common goal. Our kids learned to respect our tradition and our school. They put the program ahead of themselves."

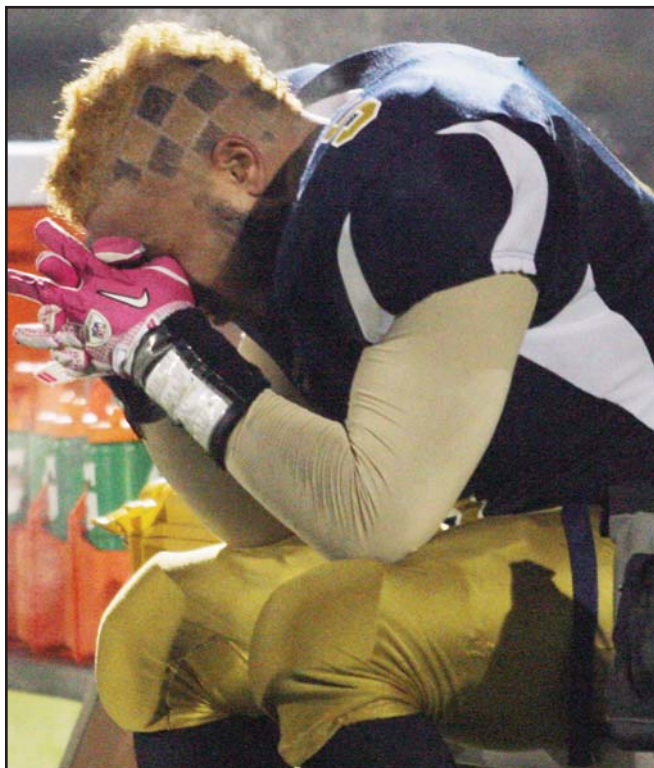

In this issue is our annual All-Football Weekly team. Before the season started I asked four area men who are deeply involved in the Western New York Football scene to help with the selection process.

Each of the four men went WAY above-and-beyond the call of duty and submitted four complete all-star teams.

I will not name these men. One of our criteria is that the committee members' identities will remain a secret. I do not want them to start getting pressured to name certain kids because people know who they are... and where they live.

Here are a few items to remember when looking over the selections.

1. All-Football Weekly: These teams are made up of players from teams that have participated with the Football Weekly. If your school has chosen not to participate, your players are not eligible. There are six teams in Western New York that chose not to participate with our magazine in 2010. Players from those four schools are not recognized on the All-Football Weekly team.

2. Positions: Each Offensive Team is made up of 1 Quarterback, 3 Running Backs, 2 Wide Receivers, 5 Offensive Lineman, 1 Tight End, 1 kicker and 1 Specialty Player... 14 total.

Each Defensive Team is made up of 4 Defensive Linemen, 4 Linebackers, 4 Defensive Backs, 1 Punter and 1 Specialty Player... 14 total.

3. Team Record: The All Football Weekly Team is loaded with players who helped their teams reach Ralph Wilson Stadium and the Section 6 finals. It makes sense... the best teams obviously have the best players. While a losing record did disqualify any player from being recognized as one of the best players in Western New York, players certainly got noticed when their teams won more games.

4. Big Games: Big regular season games and playoff games carried more weight than other games. Quite simply, big players deliver in big games.

5. Behavior Counts: Players who were suspended for behavioral reasons were not eligible for our post-season honors. The best players should carry themselves with some sense of dignity. Players who were discipline problems for their teams or their schools were not recognized at all.

Behavior counts kids... behavior counts more than winning football games.

6. Grades Count: Most of these players are superior students... or at least good students. A few struggle with academics but they try hard. Players who were academically suspended because of outright laziness were not eligible for the team. If you can't give half an effort in the classroom, we will not reward you with post-season honors.

7. One Per Customer: Many all-star teams will list players at multiple positions. For the All-Football Weekly team, each player is listed once. If a line-man is named a 1st-team offensive lineman, he is not eligible to be recognized as a 2nd-team linebacker.
