Buffalo Bills & NY National Guard Coach of the Week Bills Back With Coaching Awards

The Buffalo Bills and the National Guard are once again sponsoring the WNY Coach of the Week program for the 2014 season.

Each week throughout the 2014 season, the Bills and the Guard will recognize a Coach of the Week from WNY. The football program of the Coach of the Week will receive a \$1,000 award. At the end of the season, a Coach of the Year will be chosen from the 11 weekly winners. The football program of the Coach of the Year will receive a \$2,000 award.

Randolph coach Brent Browb was named the Buffalo Bills Coach of the Year. Brown led his team to a 13-0 record and the Cardinals won their second consecutive NYS championship.

Starting the 2012 season, the Cardinals lost to Maple Grove in Week 3 to fall to 1-2 before winning 10 straight games and claiming the NYS Class D title.

"From that point on, our team has gotten better and better and better," Brown said. "We were young last year and started out slow. Once we got a little confidence it was easier to keep it going."

"I know they merged with Chautauqua Lake last year," Brown said, "but it's still Maple Grove. It's been a rivalry for 20 years or more and those are some of the best games. Everybody gets hyped up for that game. Even though they are MGCLake now, it's a big one." more than 15 years.

"We have a bunch that have been here for a while," Brown said. "The whole staff has been around the block. That made any transition pretty easy."

Brown played quarterback at Pine Valley.

"I wasn't very good," he said. "I was a tiny little kid. We had a good running back so all I had to do was hand off."

Brown was a star pitcher and outfielder for the baseball team. He played baseball at Jamestown Community College before finishing his career at UB and Brockport.

"I coached varsity baseball for 9 years but stopped when my wife and I had kids," Brown said. "I'm going to coach modified baseball this spring."

Sweet Home Looks to Reclaim Crown

Sweet Home finished 9-1 and lost to Williamsville North in the Class A title game at Ralph Wilson Stadium. The loss broke the Panthers 69-game winning streak against WNY opponents.

Sweet Home coach John Faller said that the loss has not changed anything in his team's approach to the 2014 season.

"It didn't change anything," he said. "That was one game. Our system isn't broke. It's just a matter of execution and that night Will North executed better than we did."

"He mostly starts at nose tackle," Faller said, "but sometimes we stand him up and he plays middle linebacker."

Iverson will also start at offensive guard in 2014.

"He doesn't have the size that most defensive linemen do but he is so quick," Faller said. "If you give him an inch, he'll break through and make a play. He's quick, if he gets off the ball, he'll give the center fits trying to stay with him."

Iverson is just 5-9 and 170 pounds.

"He's a little undersized," Faller said, "but he'll hit you. He's a good football player."

Iverson is also a solid student and an energetic player. "He's a good kid with great character," Faller said. "He plays with a very high tempo. He's a chatterbox. He gets himself up that way and tries to get his teammates up too. He takes a double-team and just keeps playing hard."



Twins Provide Spark for South Park

South Park finished 7-2 and won the A South Division title in 2013. The only games the Sparks lost were against Class AA champion to Jamestown and a first-round playoff loss to Class A champion Williamsville North.

"It didn't turn out the way we wanted to at the end," coach

Tim Delaney said, "but overall it was a great season."

The success may not be a one-year thing, either. The Sparks are loaded again.

Delaney has 8 starters returning to the offense and six to the defense. An influx of new players from a JV team that finished 6-1-1 last fall will fill any holes in the lineup.

"We have an opportunity to be very, very good this year and the kids know it," Delaney said. "We have a lot of experience and we have a ton of kids coming up from a pretty successful JV team."

Delaney is encouraged heading

in the seasons opening week.

"We looked good in the scrimmage," Delaney said. "We have a really good chemistry right now. Now we have to continue that into the regular season."

Delaney is also encouraged by a new work ethic his players have bought into.

"We did a lot of work in the weight room over the off-season," he said. "Our weight room group was in the 20s all winter. We did well in the 7-on-7 passing leagues. We had great turnouts for all the camps we went to. We have built into this that the kids have to come year round, not just during the season."

Delaney is also one of the few coaches in Western New York who actually takes his players away shortly before the season.

"We go to Whispering Pines in Franklinville," Delaney said. "We have double-session practices and football meetings all day."

But the Sparks work on more than football while they are in seclusion.

"We also have team building exercises," he said. "We play volleyball, ultimate football. It's a lot of fun for the kids. It's basically football, team building and more football."

Delaney also says the setting is a fantastic social experience

for his players.

The camp is way out in the wilderness," he said, "and most of our kids have never been in that type of a setting. They have to hike to the practice field from the dorm and there is nothing around so there are no distractions."

Delaney says that the three days spent at Whispering Pines

have been so important for his program that he would recommend any coach try and do it with their own teams.

"This is our 3rd year doing this and without a doubt this has made a difference," he said. "It's just another way to make us closer as a football team."

Two reasons that Delaney is optimistic about the Sparks chances at playing in the Ralph this year are identical twins William and Willquan Burgess.

The Burgess twins played at Grover Cleveland as freshman and stayed with the program when it changed to I-Prep. The program

did not win a single game in those two seasons.

"Those two guys came over when I-Prep dropped football," Delaney said. "Their mom and dad are both South Park alumni."

Delaney knew very little about William and Quan until they enrolled at South Park.

"They are just really good football players," he said. "As they have gotten older and matured they have gotten bigger and stronger. This year, they spent a lot of time in the weight room. When they saw what kind of weight they could throw around and what a difference it made in the way they could play, they bought into it."

Both William and Quan say that have wiped the 21-0 playoff loss to Williamsville North from their memories.

"I couldn't even watch the game until about a month later," William said. "It was just heart breaking to get shut out on our home field."

Quan said he has loved his time at South Park.

"After two years, getting our first high school win was amazing," he said. "We beat Hutch Tech and it was the first time either of us had won a high school game. Hopefully, we can win a lot more this year."

Williamsville North produced the best season in school history in 2013 as the Spartans finished 9-3 and advanced to the New York State Championship game in the Carrier Dome.


To say that the Spartans stunned area football fans with their post-season run would be an enormous understatement.

Quite simply, no one saw that coming.

Williamsville North had started the season 0-2. The Spartans also entered the playoffs with a loss, giving them a less-than-stellar 4-3 record. They were the 7th-seeded team in the Section 6 playoffs.

The Spartans opened the post-season with a 21-0 win over South Park, a team that had won the A South Division title.

"Our guys played well that night," Williamsville North coach Mike Mammoliti said. "We played an almost a perfect game." was excited. A lot of people were watching the games on TV. It was just incredible."

But, despite everyone else's surprise, Mammoliti says that he actually planned for big-time success three years ago, when the current group of seniors were in the 9th grade.

"Two years ago, we brought up six sophomores and a freshman," he said. "We knew at that time that they were talented. As we hung around with them and got to know them, we realized that they were different. They were a special group."

The 2012 season was full of frustrations as the Spartans finished 4-4.

"Every game we lost that year, we lost in the fourth quarter," Mammoliti said. "Every game was a one-possession game."

However, as Mammoliti watched his team grow, he began to see just how close the Spartans were to being one of the best teams in school history.

"There's just something about this group," he said. "These guys make other people around them better. These guys are winners."

And while no one can predict another run to the NYS championship game... the fact is, the Spartans are loaded again.

After posting 5 shutouts in 2013, the Spartans have eight returning starters to the defense and six on offense.

Leading the defense are linebackers Nick and Jake Ames, a pair of identical twins that, by the end of last season, had blossomed into All-WNY candidates.

"Both of them are fast, strong and play hard," Mammoliti said. "They are exactly what you need at linebacker."

Nick says that last year's team had an advantage going into the playoffs.

"We had an edge over everybody," he said. "We played with a chip on our shoulder. We had something to prove."

Jake Ames, who is nine minutes older than his brother, says that he has not even thought about last year since he walked off the field at the Carrier Dome.

"Last year was fun," Jake said, "but this year is a new team and we have to do whatever we can for the new kids on our team."

Both players will return to start on the defense, however, this season they will be playing much more offense than they did in 2013.

"They are going to play a lot more fullback and tight end," Mammoliti said. "We want both of them on the field as much as possible."

Both players have already been offered scholarships by Division I-AA Robert Morris, but neither has made a decision on where to play in college.

"We both want to play football in college," Nick said. "If we end up at the same school, that would be great. But if we end up at different schools, it's not a big deal."

Jake wants to major in Business Management while Nick wants to major in Sports Medicine, so finding the right fit for each of them will weigh heavily into their decisions.

There have been overtures from other Division I schools, even a few Division I-A programs. None of the area's Division III schools are on the radar.

"Honestly, I think they are above that level," Mammoliti said. "I think they can play higher. It just depends on finding the right fit for them."

And while each of the twins has big decisions ahead of them, neither one has thought about anything other than winning this season.

In fact, Mammoliti said, the entire roster is thinking about this season... and this season only.

"We always say that the most important game is the next one," he said.

"As coaches, we respect every single opponent,' Quinn said. "Our coaches got the kids ready and we did what we needed to do."

The Bulls played well in the first quarter and dominated

in the fourth quarter.

However, Duquesne scored twice in the third quarter to tie the game at 21-21 and the Dukes actually pulled ahead 28-24 early in the final quarter.

"We got a takeaway and then turned it right back over," Quinn said. "We had a punt situation and Duquesne turned it



"We got the win," Quinn said, "now we need to get better from Week 1 to Week 2. We are on to the next game."

The Bulls will play at Army this weekend.

"This will be a good test for our kids," Quinn said. "This will be a good test for us and a great experience for our kids. To be able to get a little history lesson will be fantastic for our kids. We will be on the grounds where so many men and woman of our country's military have been and

If the Bulls are going to challenge for the MAC title this season, they will need a big year from QB Joe Licata.
