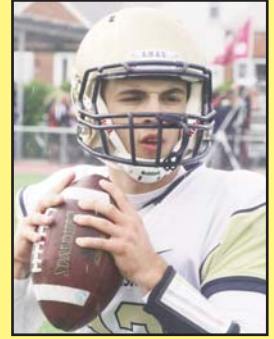

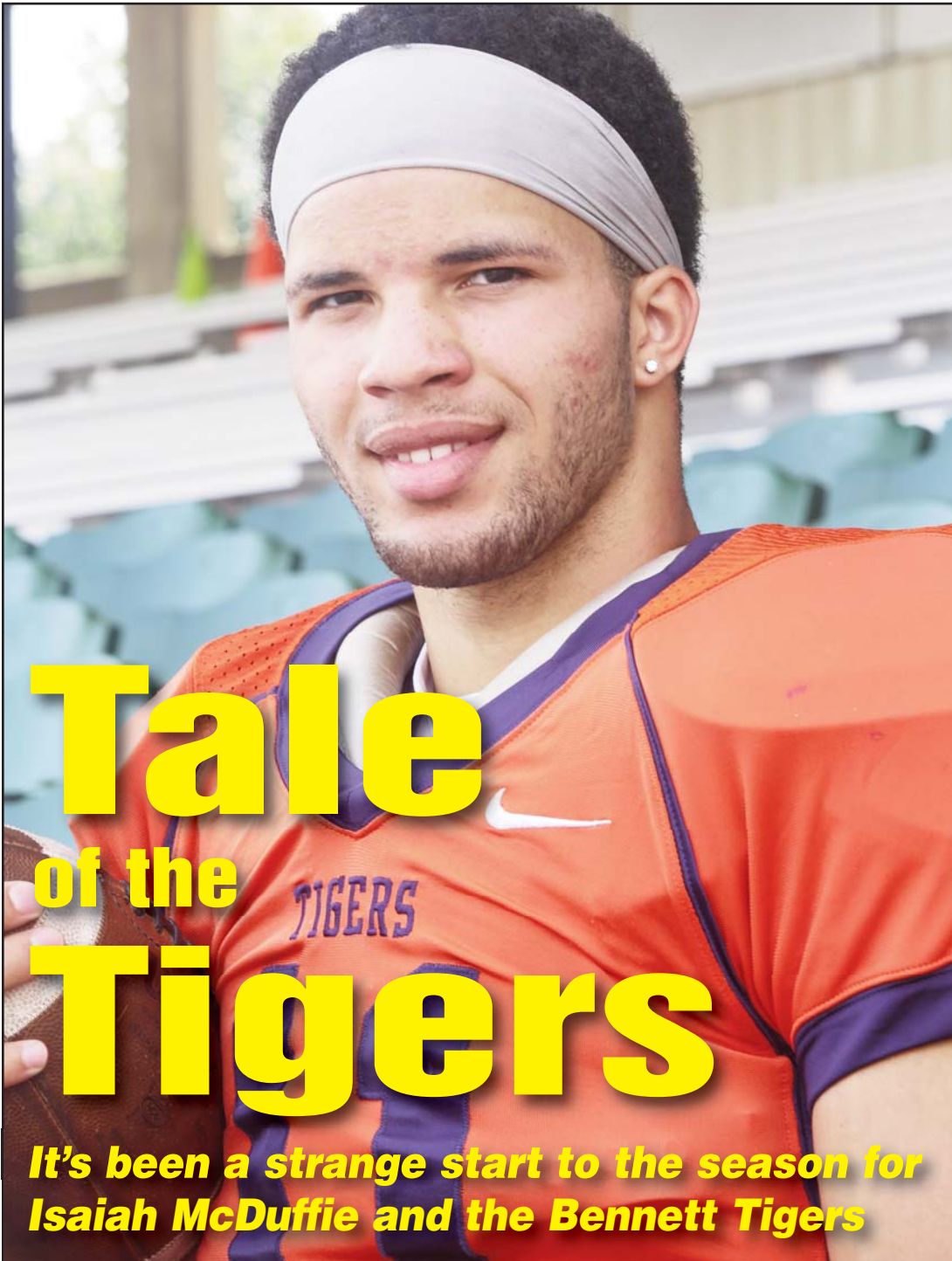

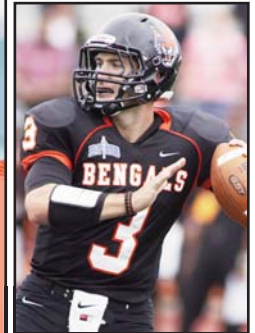

Bills Back With Coaching Awards

The Buffalo Bills and ADPRO Sports will sponsor the WNY High School Coach of the Week program for the 2015 season.

Each week throughout the 2015 season, the Bills and ADPRO will recognize a Coach of the Week from WNY. The football program of the Coach of the Week will receive a \$1,000 award. At the end of the season, a Coach of the Year will be chosen from the 11 weekly winners. The football program of the Coach of the Year will receive a \$2,000 award.

Last year, Jamestown coach Tom Langworthy was named the Coach of the Year after winning the NYS Class AA title and finishing the season with a 12-1 record.

"I was extremely honored," Langworthy said. "It was one of the top awards I have ever gotten in coaching. I couldn't believe it with all of the great coaches we have in WNY and I was extremely grateful to the Buffalo Bills for the award."

All weekly winners were invited to Ralph Wilson Stadium when the Bills hosted the Packers.

"That was great," Langworthy said, "There was a meet-and-greet before the game in the Field House with all of the Coaches of the Week from the Buffalo and Rochester area. Then we were on the sidelines to see the Bills and Packers warm up. Right before the game we were recognized in front of the crowd. It was just a tremendous experience."

Jamestown won the Section 6 title in 2013, but lost to Aquinas in the Far West Regional game. Last season the Raiders went even further as they won the Class AA title in the Syracuse Carrier Dome.

The only loss the Raiders suffered came at the hands of Canisius, which finished 30th in the nation.

"We have new goals," coach Tom Langworthy said.

"We're using last year as a confidence builder for this season."

Langworthy played high school football from 1995

through 1998 at nearby Southwestern High School. He was named a Class D All-State LB in his senior year.

Langworthy played college football at Mercyhurst College (now University) in Erie, Pa. After graduating, he took a volunteer coaching role at Southwestern under Jay Sirianni. He left after two seasons because he landed a job teaching in the Jamestown District.

Ironically, Sirianni had 4 players on last season's Southwestern team who grew up in the Jamestown District before moving to Southwestern.

"We laughed about it," Langworthy said. "Jay did pretty well with our kids. I've known Jay my whole life."

While teaching at Jamestown, Langworthy worked as an assistant JV coach for 2 seasons. He applied for the varsity head job when it came open before the 2008 season.

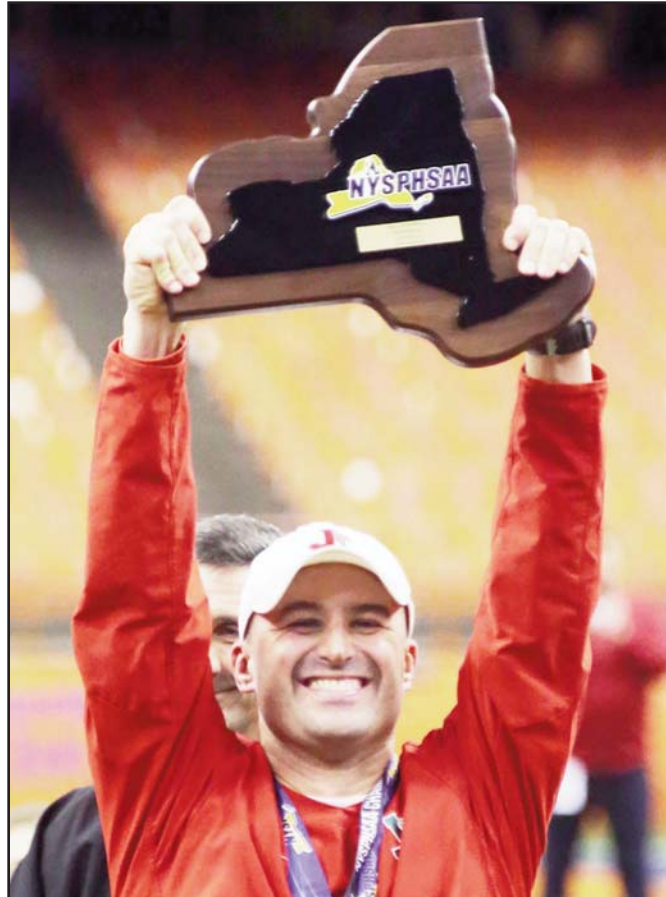

"The opportunity came open and I thought I could do the job," he said. "I had the enthusiasm and the relationship with the other coaches and the current players. I thought I was ready for it."

Langworthy's staff has been with him throughout the years of re-building Jamestown into a recognized program across New York State. Ryan Calkins (Defensive Coordinator), Richie Joly (DBs and QBs) and Dave Munella (RBs) round out the staff.

"They do an incredible job," Langworthy said. "They are just as much a part of this as I am."

Langworthy teaches 6th Grade at Jamestown's Jefferson Middle School.

Langworthy and his wife Amy have two sons, Noah (age 3) and Grant (17 months).

Armenia to Lead Sweet Home Lines

Sweet Home finished 9-2 in 2014 and won the Section 6 Class A title for the 7th time in 8 years. The Panthers lost to Irondequoit 24-21 in the Far West Regional.

This season, Sweet Home will be a very different team than in past seasons. Panthers coach John Faller has just 4 starters returning on both offense and defense.

"Every year is different," Sweet Home coach John Faller said. "Last year's seniors will be tough to replace but that's high school ball."

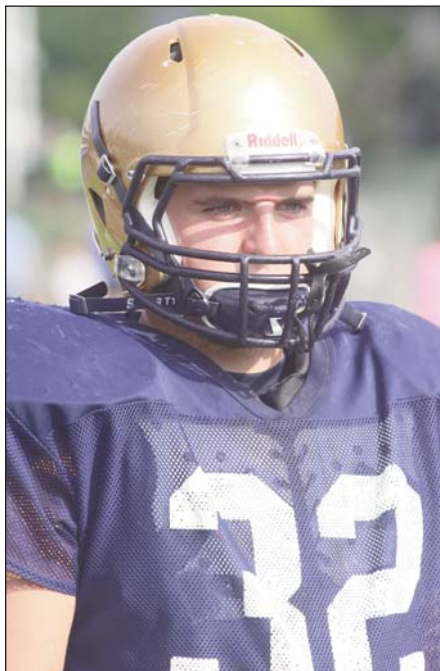

Armenia, won Sweet Home's Iron Panther contest in the off-season. Faller's annual contest includes weight lifting, 40-yard dash, vertical jumps and other combine-like tests.

"We've been running it since 1986," Faller said. "Just to keep the kids active and competitive."

Armenia (6-0, 215) was timed at 4.8 in the 40-yard dash.

"He's got good speed," Faller said. "He's not huge but he's strong."

Armenia also kicks PATs and field goals for Sweet Home.

"He's one of the better kickers in the area," Faller said. "He's also our back-up punter. He's a lineman but he's a good athlete too."

Armenia also maintains a 98-academic average while taking a full course of Advanced Placement classes,

"Kids that are top students like that are disciplined and come in with a good attitude," Faller said. "They know that hard work and preparation pays off in the class room. It does in football, too. We have an Advanced Placement Football Program and Joe excels in both areas."

Austin Wilson, Jon Phillips and Joe Armenia are captains and 2-way starters.

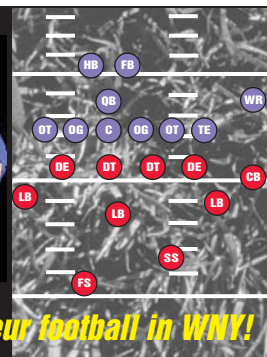
"We want to try and start them on just one side of the ball to keep them fresh," Faller said, "but sometimes we can't avoid it."

Armenia, who started at LB in 2014, will be moving to the offensive and defensive lines this fall.

"He'll play offensive tackle and defensive end this season," Faller said. "We have a real need for some experienced players there."

Stranahan named Canisius QB

It would be hard to top what Canisius accomplished in the 2014 season. The Crusaders finished 12-0 and won the first NYS Catholic Championship. They were also ranked #1 in the final New York State Class AA Sportswriters Poll and finished the year ranked 30th in the nation in USA Today poll.

“Anytime you finished nationally ranked, it’s a tough act to follow,” Canisius coach Rich Robbins said, “but this is a new season. We don’t talk about what happened last year. We don’t talk about going undefeated.”

Robbins says that the Crusaders have two very specific goals each season.

“We want to win a Msgr. Martin title,” he said, “and we want to win another state championship. Beyond that, we want to get better each week.”

Canisius will open the season at the Syracuse Carrier Dome when they play Section 2 power Shenendehowa in the Kickoff Classic.

Canisius was originally scheduled to play against Section 9’s Monroe-Woodbury.

“Monroe-Woodbury dropped out of the event and we didn’t have an opponent,” Robbins said. “But the organizers asked Shenendehowa if they wanted to play. Their coach Brian Clawson knew it was a great opportunity for his kids to play in the Dome so they accepted the invitation.”

That was just fine with Robbins. He has a history with the Albany-area school.

“I was actually in the Shenendehowa School District and played football for them until the 8th grade,” Robbins said. “But after 7th grade my family moved to Pittsburgh and I played high school ball down there.”

Shenendehowa has a long history of success on the football field. Longtime coach Brent Steuerwald retired after the 2011 season with 318 wins, which is third all-time in New York State history.

“My dad and my uncles played in Shen for Coach Steuerwald,” Robbins said. “I met him at one of the NYS Coaches Conventions a few years ago and I introduced myself.”

Steuerwald remembered Robbins’ father and uncles. “We had a nice chance to catch up,” he said. “It’s going to be really cool to play against the team that I first put on pads for.” Robbins says that he fully understands the Shen tradition.

“They have had good football in that town for a long time,” he said. “Shen comes out of Section 2 and is the Final Four every other year. They have a proud tradition.”

Robbins will take the field at the Carrier Dome with a squad that returns just two starters from last season.

“That’s not a lot,” he said, “but it’s business as usual for us. We have a lot of seniors this year that are really good players. They’ve been waiting their turn and will have a chance to get on the field and make a name for themselves. This is a good group.”

Senior Tyler Stranahan will start at QB for Canisius.

“He transferred to our school from St. Joe’s before his junior year,” Robbins said. “He backed up Jacob Louks and spent last year learning the offense and the terminology.”

Stranahan won the job with a solid training camp.

“It has been a 4-man competition all summer long and he won the job,” Robbins said. “He has the most in-game experience from last year. He is a great athlete and can scramble when a play breaks

down.”

Stranahan has been working towards this season for the past two years.

“He spent the last 2 years working with quarterback coach Jim Kubiak,” Robbins said. “He has a very strong arm and he knows our offense.”

Stranahan also wrestled at Canisius in the 187-pound weight class.

He’s a good leader and a fierce competitor,” Robbins said. “He’s just a tough kid. When your quarterback is also a wrestler, it speaks to his toughness.”

Stranahan (5-11, 185) was voted as a team captain.

“The kids know who they trust and who they want to lead them,” Robbins said. “He’s a hard-working kid and he’s glad he’s going to get this chance.”

Jenkins Leads Lockport

Lockport finished 2-6 in 2014 and lost to eventual NYS champion Jamestown in the first round of the playoffs.

"They were the best team in the state," Lockport coach Greg Bronson said, "and they beat us pretty bad."

The Lions lost a number of players to graduation. Bronson has just four starters returning to both the offense and the defense, 3 of them are 2-way starters.

"We lost quite a few of our linemen to graduation," Bronson said. "We've got good players but we have just 38 total kids on the team. We have the lowest numbers in my 29 years here so we'll have to stay healthy."

One lineman

who will play a huge role for the Lions is senior D'Andre Jenkins

He has started at defensive end for us since his sophomore year," Bronson said. "He had two interceptions in our upset win at Orchard Park and he almost returned one for a touchdown."

Jenkins (6-3, 250) also saw time at FB and TE in 2014.

"He is an extremely athletic kid for his size. "He has speed and he can move."

This fall, Jenkins has moved positions and will start at OT.

"We lost so many linemen," Bronson said, "that we asked him to move to tackle. He'll be at left tackle on a permanent basis. He has been one of our most effective linemen through camp."

Jenkins played well in the season's opening scrimmage last week.

"He's a hard worker," Bronson said. "and he did really well. We use him to pull on offense. When he turns the corner and gets up the hole,

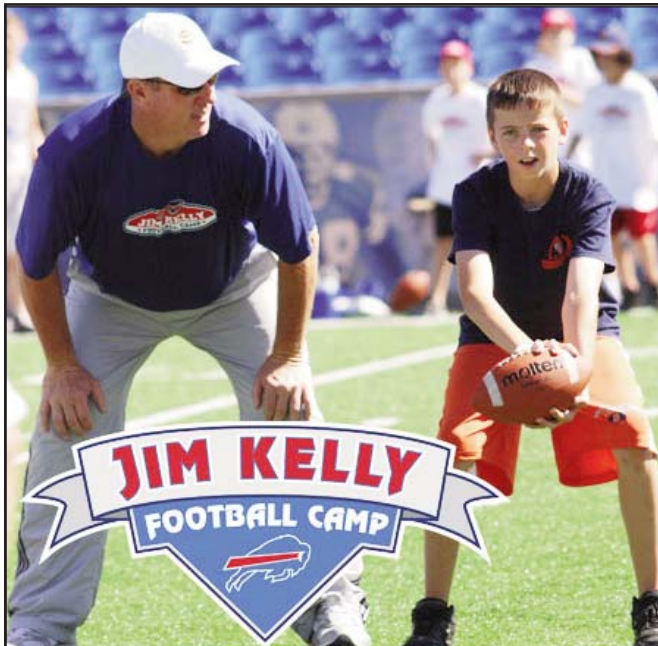
there is a huge collision in there. He knocked some people off their feet in the scrimmage."

Jenkins is a team captain this season. "He's an intense and emotional player on the field. There are not a lot of kids who can play with him."

Jamestown finished 12-1 in 2014 and won the NYS Class AA championship. The only loss the Raiders suffered came at the hands of Canisius, which finished 30th in the nation.

"We have new goals," coach Tom Langworthy said. "We're using last year as a confidence builder for this year."

Langworthy has not had to remind his players that the 2014 season is over.

"We have stuff we want to accomplish in 2015," he said. "This is a new season and these kids want to experience their own success this year."

Jamestown has plenty of holes in the lineup to fill.

Holland struggled early in the season in 2014 but by the end of the year he was a solid player on a state champion team.

"We just tried to make him better every day," Langworthy said. "He's very coachable. We had some tough ball games early but those helped him mature.

The confidence he gained really helped him down the stretch."

Holland is a solid student, maintaining a 93 academic average.

"He knows he has to be a great leader," Langworthy said. "He's not afraid to demand the best out of his teammates."

After several years of making the Class A playoffs, Grand Island finished a disappointing 4-5 in 2014 and lost in the title game of the Funke Tournament.

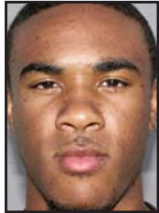

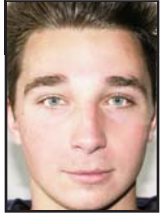

stands the game of football

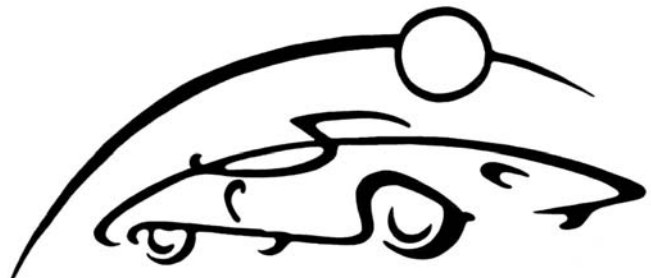
Hart has also been a starter on the Albion baseball team since his freshman year.

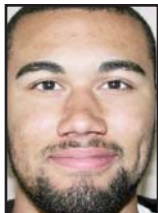

The Tigers' Tale

Strange Start to the Season for Bennett and Isaiah McDuffie

Bennett coach Steve McDuffie is starting his 5th year as coach of the Tigers squad. Without a doubt, this may be the strangest start to a season he's ever experienced.

Last year, the Tigers finished 9-1 and lost to Cheektowaga in the Class B title game.

The end of the season was both exhilarating and crushingly disappointing.

Since the City of Buffalo teams disbanded the old Harvard Cup League and joined the Section 6 Federation, every City team had worked hard to catch up with the rest of WNY.

"I won 3 Harvard Cups myself," McDuffie said, "but at some we had to put the old tradition behind us. We needed to move to Section 6."

Once joining, each of the City programs either improved dramatically or folded entirely. However, every year, fans of the Harvard Cup League would chafe when no City team would advance to Ralph Wilson Stadium.

Finally, after six seasons, Bennett joined South Park as the first two City of Buffalo teams to play at The Ralph.

"It was an electrifying time," McDuffie said. "We saw the City of Buffalo rally around those two teams. Everybody in the city was backing both of those teams and the atmosphere in school was fantastic. It was phenomenal, not just for Bennett but for the whole city."

Bennett led the title game 28-7 after three quarters but lost 36-34 in one of the most thrilling games ever at the Ralph.

To come so close to winning a championship, and watching it slip away in the fourth quarter, was crushing.

"It was truly a great experience," McDuffie said. "But,

we wanted to win. It left a pretty bitter taste for everybody. We should have won and we let it get away. We didn't finish the job."

McDuffie says that, starting the week after the loss, his returning players began working to returning to the Ralph.

"We only graduated 5 seniors, 4 of them were starters," he said. "That loss really motivated the kids on the team. We had 20 guys take on a leadership role. They have worked hard in the classroom and the weight room. They are determined to get back and win this time."

Visitors who watch a practice at Bennett notice immediately, there is hardly any talking and none of the banter that is usually heard at a high school football practice. It's almost eerie how silent the Tigers practices are.

"There is not a lot of talking at all," McDuffie said. "This group is very

focused and they are all business. These kids all want the same thing. Hopefully we can be the first city school that wins a state title."

But the season has already started in an odd manner. Bennett, a large high school, has incredibly dropped down in size and will play in Class C this year.

The reason has nothing to do with actual football.

Bennett was labeled as a "failing" school and the City of Buffalo School Board has decided to close the school.

"Bennett is being phased out and they are phasing Middle College in," McDuffie said. "Last year, we didn't have a 9th grade. This year we have no 9th or 10th grade."

The school's size is determined by the average daily attendance and, with no 9th or 10th grades, Bennett barely fell into for Class C - just one student away from playing in the larger Class B.

"We had already submitted our numbers to the state," McDuffie said. "That was done before the Board decided anything. A few weeks later, they started to move Middle College into the building."

So, the Bennett kids are now sharing their building with kids who are attending Middle College - whose kids have to play at South Park.

"It's a very odd situation," McDuffie said. "I wish we had been able to do this a little differently, but our players and coaches really have no say in the matter."

Bennett has already been proclaimed as the Class C champion. With 5 offensive linemen who weigh at least 280 pounds, the Tigers will have a ridiculous size advantage over the other small-school teams in Class C.

"There's nothing I could do about it," McDuffie said. "The kids goal was to be able to play Maine-Endwell and try to dethrone them. They were disappointed because they wanted to be the best at a higher level."

McDuffie tried to compensate by scheduling a game against Orchard Park, a traditional Class AA power.

"We want to play one of the best teams in WNY," McDuffie said. "We have to play who they tell us but for our non-league game, we wanted to try and find the best competition that we can."

Oh, by the way, in addition having a huge size advantage over every other Class C team, the Tigers starting RB from 2014, has already committed to play at Syracuse after graduation.

Isaiah McDuffie, Steve's son, was offered a scholarship to Syracuse to play football before he started his junior season. Isaiah has verbally committed to the Orange.

"Syracuse offered Isaiah last summer when we came back from their camp," Steve McDuffie said. "UB and Penn State had also offered him. We had a coach come in from UConn to offer him and Washington State also offered."

Isaiah McDuffie says he chose Syracuse because it was close to home.

"It's always been my dream to play college football in a Power Conference," Isaiah said. "It's been my dream since I was a little kid."

McDuffie says that, while he has verbally committed, he is more focused on winning at Bennett right now.

"We plan on having a big year," Isaiah said. "We have great teammates and we are just a big family. We want to win this thing together."

Steve McDuffie says that the Tigers are playing for more than a Section 6 title at The Ralph - or even a NYS title.

"These kids are playing for their school," he said. "Bennett has a long tradition in football and these kids are trying to save their school. They don't want Bennett to close. We get no say in that. The only say we have is on the field this year."

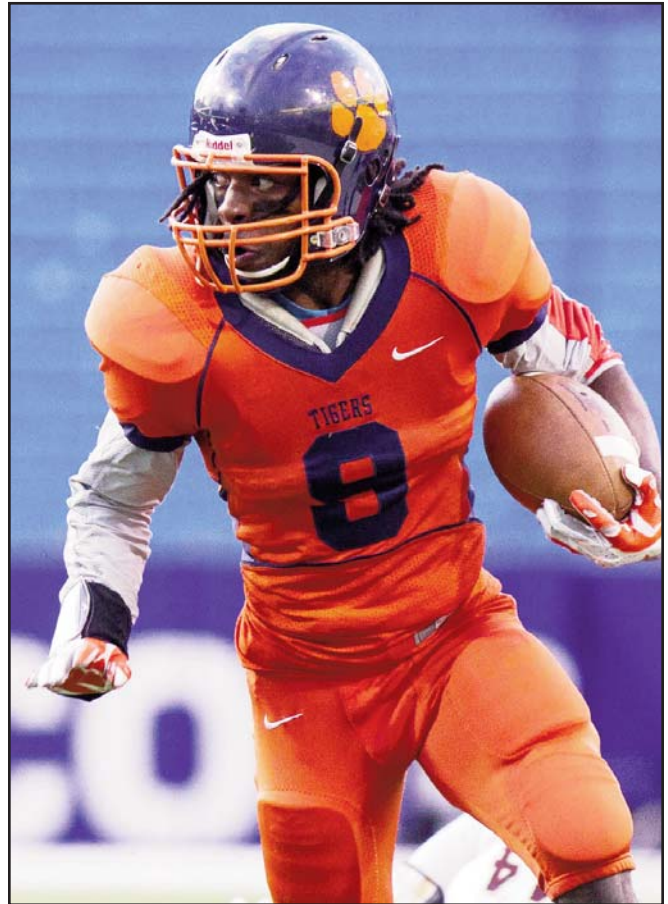

Junior QB 'Hoppy' to be at BSC

Last season, Buffalo State finished 8-3 and won the ECAC Southwest Bowl over Waynesburg (Pa.) University.

It was the Bengals first post-season game since the 2000 season.

"There is a parallel to 1986 when we were starting a new program," Buff State coach Jerry Boyes said. "We went through our growing pains and it took five years before we won our first post-season bowl game in 1991."

After Boyes left the coaching job to become Buffalo State's Athletic Director, the program fell on hard times. He returned as the Bengals head coach in 2009.

"We went through the same growing pains," he said, "and it took five years to get a post-season game."

Boyes said he expected nothing different when he returned to coaching the Bengals.

"It's never an overnight process," he said. "Changing a losing culture takes time. We needed to recruit players that want to win. It takes persistence and perseverance when you are building a football program or a business or anything else."

Boyes says that, while BSC has taken similar paths in his two stints as head coach, nothing is guaranteed.

"Can we keep the parallel going and have success so that we can move into the NCAA playoffs like we did in 1992?" he asked. "We'll know the answer to that in the next 10 weeks."

Boyes won Division III national championship as the QB at Ithaca College but has never talked about that with his players at Buffalo State.

"The ultimate goal is to win the Stagg Bowl but we never talk about it," he said. "The only thing we talk about is what it takes to be successful."

Boyes has a very simple definition of success.

"It's an inner satisfaction of a job well-done," he said. "We may not win the game but we gave our best effort and didn't beat ourselves. If the other team played well and beat us, we move on. Sometimes you may not win but I can live with that."

If Buffalo State is going to make a return to the NCAA

playoffs this season, they will need as big season from QB Kyle Hoppy.

Hoppy is starting his junior season at Buff State. He led Orchard Park to a NYS championship and after graduation, moved into professional baseball.

"Kyle was one of the top QBs to come out of WNY," Boyes said, "but we didn't even talk with him because he had already decided that he was going to play professional baseball."

Hoppy spent four seasons in the Baltimore Orioles minor league system before leaving baseball.

"He chased that dream," Boyes said, "which is what you want when you are an athlete."

When Hoppy returned to WNY, he re-connected with an old high school teammate Garrett McLaughlin - who was now an assistant coach at Buff State.

"Garrett got him interested in playing for us," Boyes said. "He enrolled here in the spring of 2013 as a freshman."

Hoppy spent his first season with the Bengals as a back-up behind senior Casey Kacz.

"He spent a year getting the rust off," Boyes said. "He played a little

bit but didn't get a ton of opportunities. He came into the season as the starter last year."

Hoppy had a solid season in 2014. He had a QB rating of 161, completed 54 percent of his passes and threw 22 TD passes and just 6 interceptions.

"He had very good stats," Boyes said. "Now we want to expand his game."

Hoppy passed for over 2,200 yards in 2014 and also averaged 7.8 yards per carry.

"Kyle has speed," Boyes said. "He is a multi-threat quarterback. He can hurt you with the arm and his legs."

Hoppy's teammates voted him as a team captain last season... a rare occurrence for a sophomore.

"When it's all said and done, he will, in all likelihood, be our only 3-time captain ever," Boyes said.

College players placing that amount of trust in a sophomore is unheard of.

"It says everything about his character and leadership," Boyes said, "and it made him even more confident as a leader. We only benefit because of that."

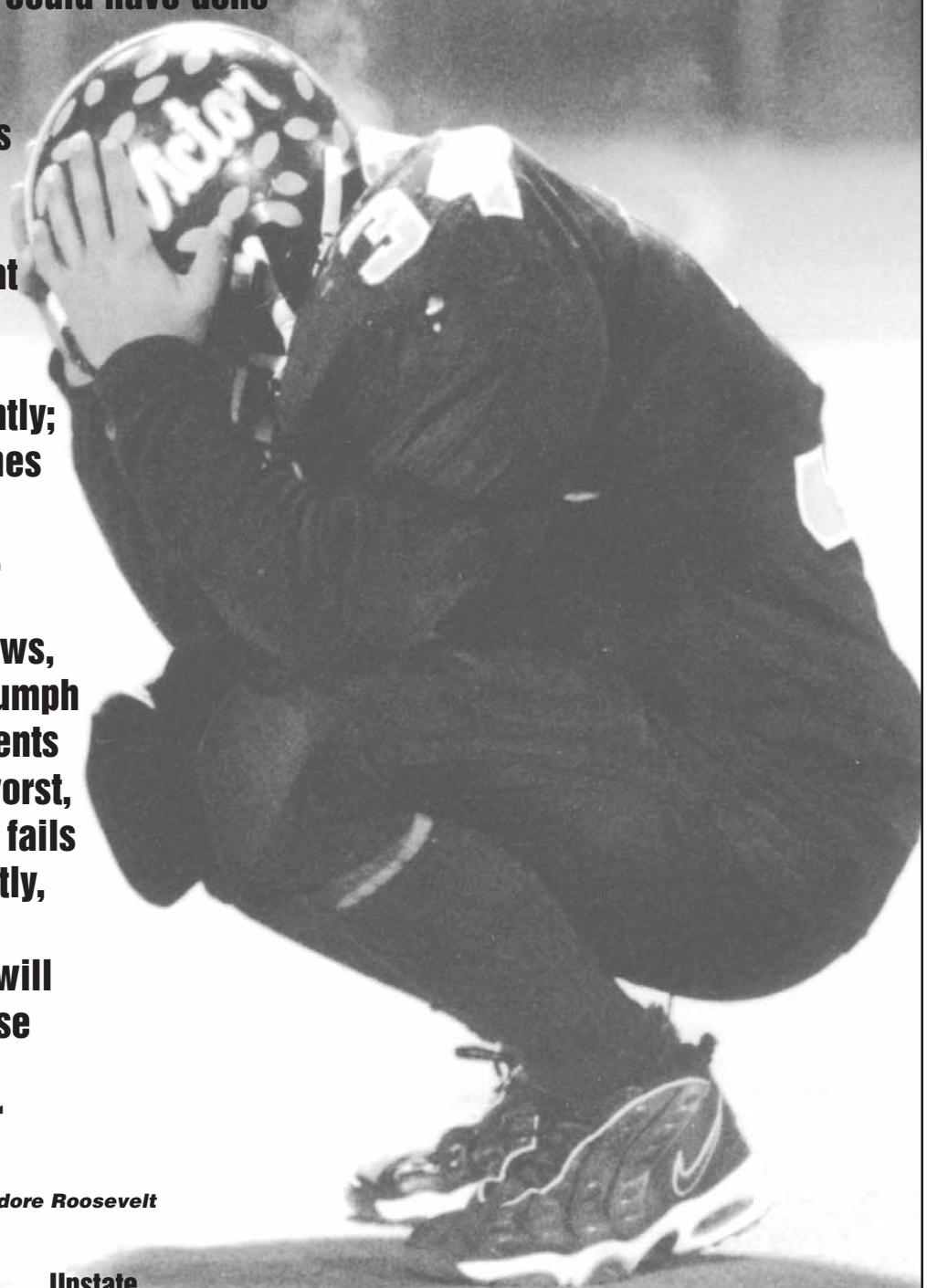
