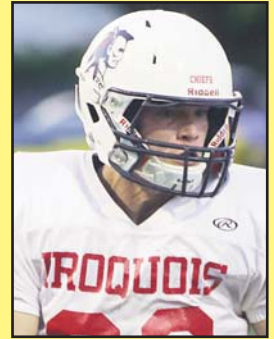

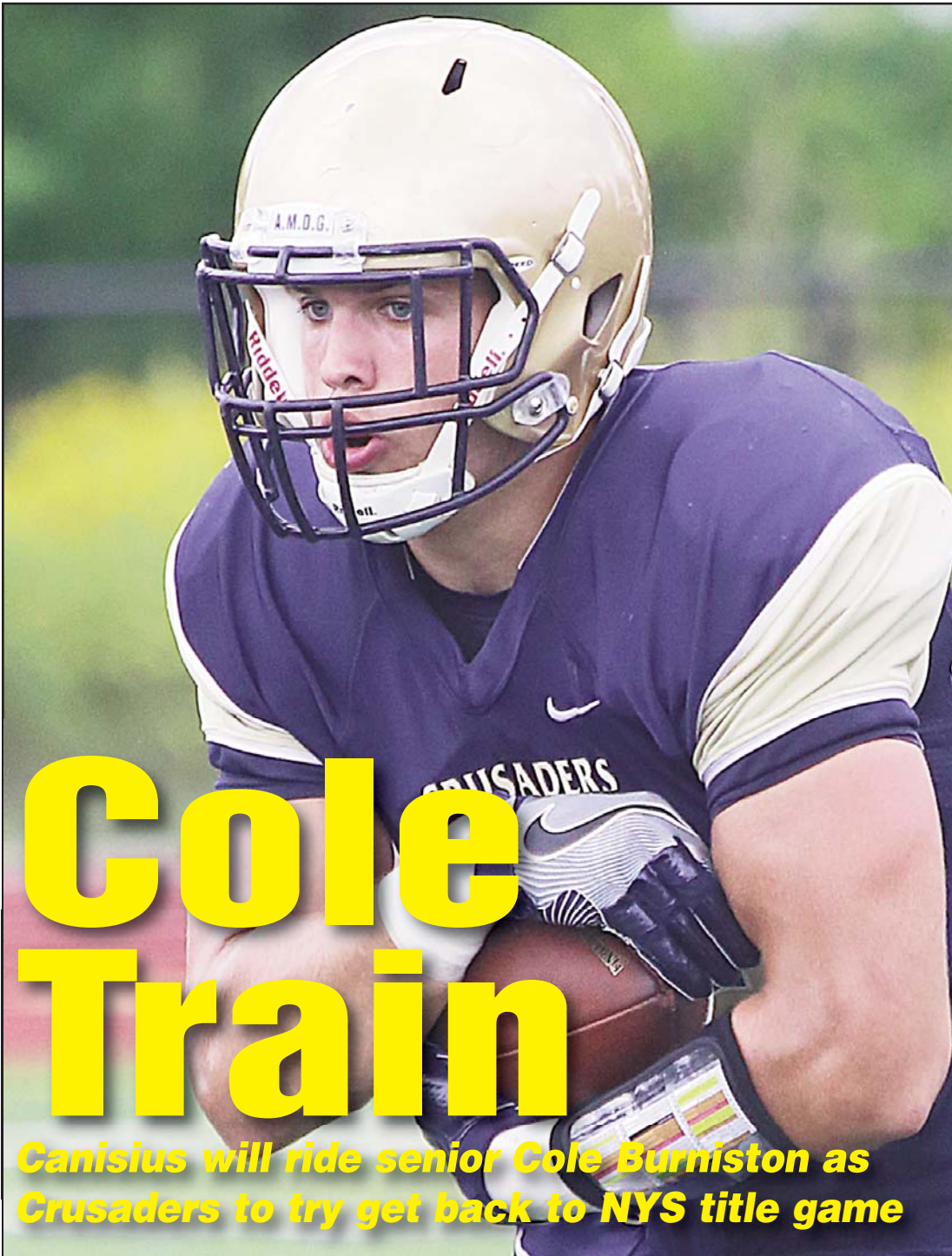

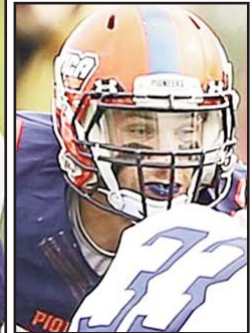

Alessi Leads Eden to Stunning Win

Eden coach Mike Alessi has been named the Coach of the Week by the Buffalo Bills and ADPRO Sports after his team beat Chautauqua Lake 21-15 on a Tuesday night.

It was the first varsity win of Alessi's coaching career. He didn't actually get the job until June, when head coach Chuck Tilley had to step away due to family reasons.

"It wasn't a lot of time to prepare for the season," he said.

This is actually the second straight season that Alessi was named a head coach in June. In 2015, Eden announced in June that the school would be unable to field a varsity team.

"It was actually easier this year," Alessi said. "I already knew all the kids. Last year I didn't know any of them. Some of them went over to play varsity at Lake Shore."

The Den program is trying to rebuild - literally.

"We don't have much money," Alessi said. "We are short on pants for the program. The school is helping and some people are sending us money. But we are on fumes."

The fact that Eden beat Chautauqua Lake is astounding. Due to a quirk in the scheduled, the Raiders were forced to play two games in four days.

Eden lost to JFK on Friday, Sept., 2 and the Raiders had to turn around and play at Chautauqua Lake on Tuesday, September 6th.

"Since we played on Friday, we weren't allowed to practice on Saturday," Alessi said. "The kids were still sore on Sunday so we didn't do anything. We just had a walk-through on Monday."

Pulling a game plan together was difficult.

"The staff just had one day," Alessi said. "We were going off of scrimmage film, which is hard enough. It was about as basic a game plan as you could get."

Eden fell behind 9-0 in the first half.

"We started really slow," Alessi said. "Our kids weren't ready for a Tuesday game. I think they were still sleeping."

But the Raiders battled back, led by senior Owen Krouse who rushed for 121 yards and 3 TDs.

"It was just guts," Alessi said. "He just couldn't have had much in his tank."

Eden finally took the lead 21-15 in the 4th quarter. The

Raiders were trying to run out the clock when they lost a fumble at midfield, giving C-Lake one final chance.

"We don't have a lot of kids on the sidelines to sub in," Alessi said. "Our kids were just about done. I was just hoping for a turnover or something."

Chautauqua Lake drove down to the 4-yard line with just :01 left on the clock. Time for one play.

"They rolled their quarterback out," Alessi said. "He had run all over the place."

But Krouse came up and made a game-saving tackle on the 3-yard line.

"Owen is the only kid on our team that played varsity football last year," Alessi said. "He has just taken the leadership role and ran off with it."

Krouse is a 3-year varsity starter. However, he started last year at Lake Shore after Eden dropped their varsity program.

"He has speed, quickness and some power," Alessi said. "He's got some moves but he was running on fumes the entire game. It's crazy to think what he could do if he had some more time off between games."

The bus ride home was somewhat quiet, despite the win.

"On the way home, it was surreal," Alessi said. "Our kids were exhausted."

Alessi also had the added burden of knowing his wife

was facing surgery for breast cancer three days later.

"Knowing what we would have to go through, it was a lot for me on the ride home," he said.

Alessi and his wife Annie have been married for 4 years. They have two small children; Michael is 4 and Ava is 2.

"We found out Annie has breast cancer in March," Alessi said. "Her surgery was Friday and we have a home nurse that is going to help us for a while."

Alessi, who works overnights at Haiers Trucking, has been a coach for 10 years. He coached at ECC for one season before moving to the modified program at Hamburg. He has been with the Eden program for 5 years now.

He will miss this week's game to stay home with Annie.

"Thank God I have a great staff," he said. "I'm not going to practices or games this week. But after watching what they did last week, I know our kids will take it to the next level."

Iroquois and Yax Face Big Test

Iroquois jumped out to a 30-0 lead at the half and beat Riverside 43-0 last week. It was the Chiefs second straight shutout to start the season. Iroquois beat Lake Shore 36-0 in the season opener.

"Keeping two teams out of the end zone is a nice way to start the season," coach Keith Marshall said. "But we played against teams that are very young. We have a lot of experience and I think it showed."

Marshall says that despite the two impressive victories, his team is far from accomplishing much.

"We have a long way to go," he said. "Our Class A in Section 6 is one of the best leagues in the state. No matter who you play each week, you're going to be in a real fight."

This week, the Chiefs will play their biggest regular-season game in a few years when they face undefeated Bennett.

The teams will kick off at 7pm at All-High Stadium on Friday night. The winner have sole possession of first place and own 3 wins in league games.

"Bennett has some of the best linebackers I've seen in a while," Marshall said. "They are extremely quick."

Bennett also has a Connolly Cup candidate in RB Isaiah McDuffie. He has already committed to playing at Boston College next fall.

"Obviously everything starts with McDuffie," Marshall said, "but Marcelus Toliver is not a bad running back, either. It's a huge challenge and one we are looking forward to."

Last season, Iroquois was a good team that was inconsistent. They lost games they should not have. Then, after making the playoffs as a 7th seed, they upset undefeated Starpoint in the first round.

"We have a lot of talent back from last year," Marshall said, "but we haven't proven anything yet. This is an opportunity to take the next step and prove we belong in the top half of Class A South."

Marshall says his players have noticed that, despite posting a pair of shutouts, they were left out of the WNY Top 10 in the Buffalo News poll this week. Bennett is ranked 7th.

"The kids notice that stuff more than I do," Marshall said. "I'm busy watching game film and don't want to get caught up in all that."

Marshall did tell his players there is one way to get into the WNY Top 10.

"You have to earn that kind of stuff," he said. "If you think you are good, you need to prove it and win."

If Iroquois is going to beat Bennett and move on through the A South, they will be relying on senior Brandon Yax.

"We rode him last year," Marshall said. "He set the school record for carries in a game (44)," Marshall said. "He is as strong and durable as they come."

Yax (5-11, 190) rushed for 1,468 yards on 268 carries in 2015.

"That's a lot of carries for a high school back," Marshall said. "We are trying to cut back for him a little, but he is our feature back."

Yax has rushed for 341 yards and 7 TDs through the season's first two games.

"No one has worked more on his physical well-being than Brandon," Marshall said. "He has never missed a 6am weight room session in the middle of winter."

Yax may be one of the strongest RBs in WNY, constantly gaining 2 or 3 extra yards after he is wrapped up by the defense.

"He is very difficult to tackle by two people," Marshall says. "That doesn't surprise me. I've seen all the behind-the-season work he has put in."

Marshall says that Yax could play college football.

"I think he'll get a few opportunities," he said. "There is no doubt in my mind that he can play college football."

Yax also doesn't say a ton, according to Marshall.

"He's extremely quiet and extremely humble," he said.

"His work ethic is amazing. He is a classic kids that leads by example. We started workouts the Monday after Thanksgiving. He was the first kid there."

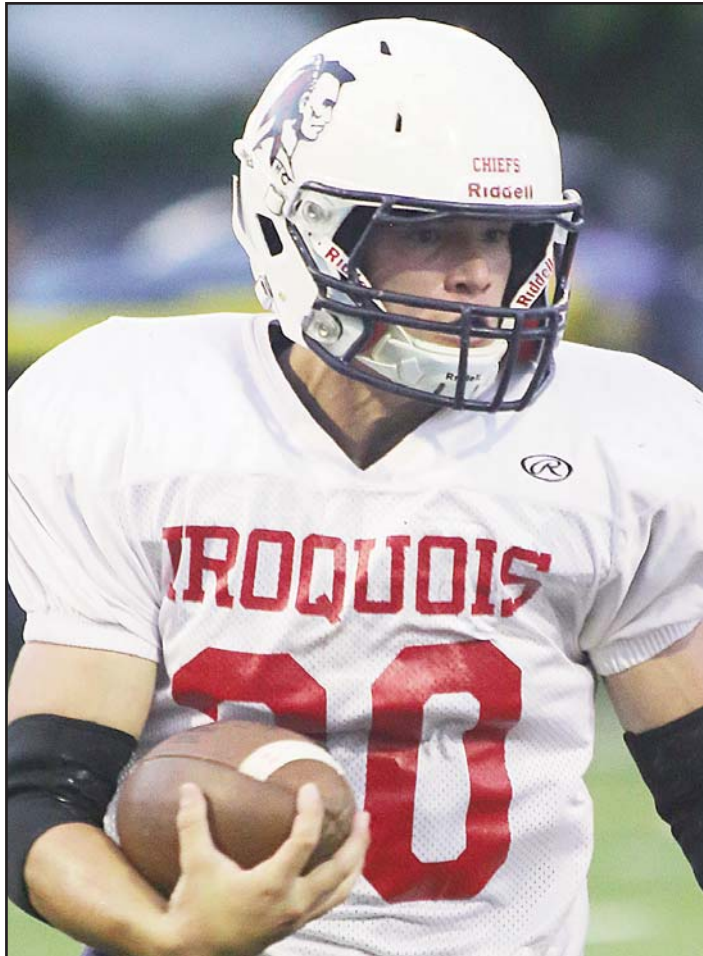

Lynch Steps in for West

Kenmore West fell behind 16-0 at the half and battled hard but lost to Williamsville North 22-12 last week.

"I thought we ran the ball very well," Kenmore West coach John Haynes said.

"We played pretty good on defense but we had a couple of breakdowns that turned into big plays."

Kenmore West dropped to 1-1 with the loss and will play undefeated Niagara Falls this weekend.

"They are a physical team" Haynes said, "and they are very fast and athletic."

Haynes said that his players have to be prepared to see just about anything from the Falls.

"They have a variety of formations to prepare for," he said.

In the loss to Kenmore West, Jamir Lynch had a big day as he rushed for 110 yards on 15 carries and 2 TDs, one of them a 64-yarder.

"He's an elusive runner," Haynes said, "and a very physical player on defense."

Lynch played RB and WR in 2015. The plan was to have him play there again but starting QB Andrew Fron suffered a knee injury in the season-opening win against Riverside.

"We won't know how bad it is until we get the results of the MRI," Haynes said. "We need Jamir to step in."

Haynes is confident that Lynch can handle the new role.

"Jamir is very knowledgeable about the game," Haynes said. "He is driven to produce, both on and off the field."

Lynch leads the Blue Devils with 131 yards rushing and 4 TDs. He has also caught 4 passes for 84 yards.

"He's athletic,"

Haynes said, "He can make plays."

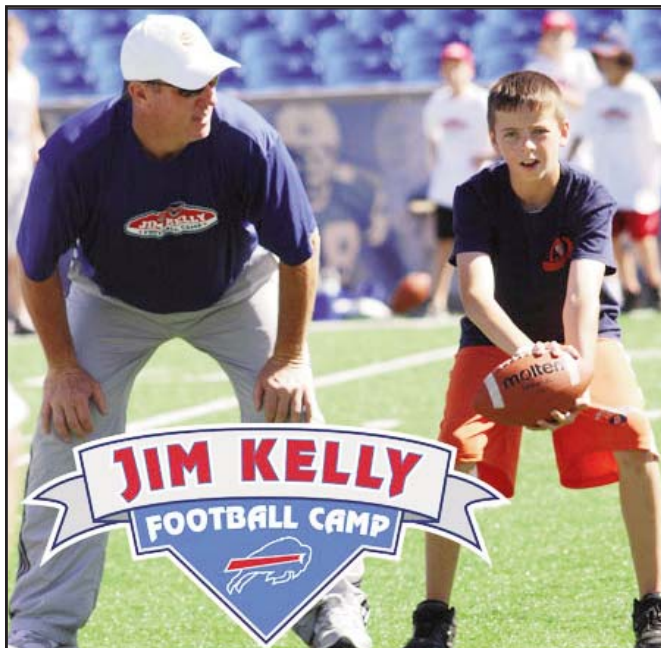
Lynch, who also plays basketball for Kenmore West, was named a captain before the season.

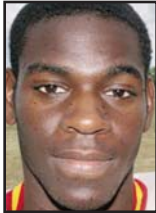

Starpoint Relies on Robinson

Starpoint fell behind 14-0 in the first quarter but rallied to beat Amherst 28-14 last week.

"We were very focused," coach Al Cavagnaro said. "We focused on every play, just one play at a time."

Cavagnaro says he is using a Lou Holtz quote as motivation for his team this season. He pulled it out when the Spartans fell behind.

"Lou Holtz said 'W.I.N. What's Important Now?'" Cavagnaro said. "We talked about it when we fell behind so early."

The Spartans are now 2-0 and will play undefeated Grand Island. It will be the first home game played on a Friday night in Starpoint history.

"Grand Island is physical so we need to be prepared for that," Cavagnaro said. "They are well-coached and they will be well-prepared in all phases of the game."

Anthony Robinson helped the Spartans ground game as he rushed for 89 yards

and 2 TDs on just 6 carries. Robinson scored on runs of 5 and 37 yards.

"He played within himself," Cavagnaro said. "He always does his best."

When he was still a 6th-grade student,

Robinson introduced himself to Cavagnaro.

"He said he couldn't wait to play for me," Cavagnaro said. "I had coached his father here, who was also an excellent player."

Robinson (5-11, 230) has rushed for 143 yards and 3 TDs through the first two games.

"He has speed and agility for his size," Cavagnaro said. "He works hard and wants to play at the next level."

Robinson, who maintains an academic average in the high 80s, is also on the wrestling and track teams at Starpoint. He throws the shot and discus in the spring.

"Anthony usually leads by example," Cavagnaro said, "but he can be vocal when we need it."

Broad Steps in at WS West

West Seneca West controlled the line of scrimmage and played solid defense as they beat Sweet Home 13-6 last week.

"We improved our play on the defensive side of the ball," coach Mike Vastola said.

"We made some personnel changes and challenged the kids to improve. We were really happy with the results."

The Indians rushed for 228 yards and held Sweet Home to 47 yards on the ground.

"We need to always improve in every facet of the game," Vastola said. "but we need to do a better job of converting when we get into the red zone."

Junior QB Jesse Broad rushed 20 times for 94 yards, including a 3-yard TD in the first half.

"He's a receiver and does not want to play quarterback," Vastola said.

Unfortunately, West Seneca West starter Brendan Tait was injured in the season-opener against Hamburg.

"When Brendan went down, Jesse kind

of begrudgingly entered the game."

Broad led the Indians to three scoring drives in the 4th quarter.

"All he did was execute the offense to the best of his ability," Vastola said.

In the win over Sweet Home, the Panthers had trouble finding Broad.

"He got tough yards," Vastola said. "and he got us a win. He's a great competitor. He hates to lose."

Broad (5-10, 150) is not a physically dominant player, but gets the job done wherever he is playing.

"Jesse is a jack-of-all-trades," Vastola said. "We need to get the ball in his hands.

organized sports."

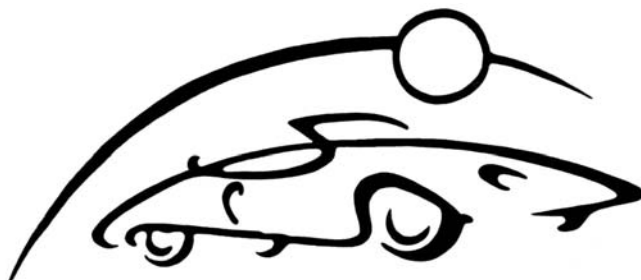
Cooper (6-5, 180) was an all-league player in basketball last winter. He also went to the NYS Meet for track.

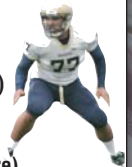

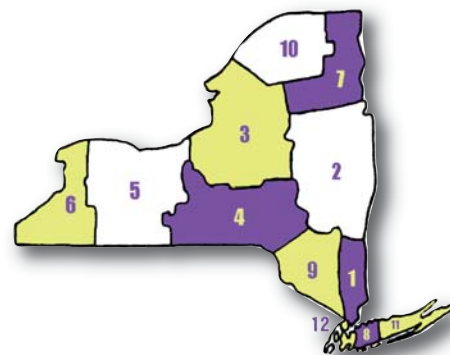

Canisius will ride Canadian senior Cole Burniston this fall

Canisius opened up a 28-0 lead at the half and went on to beat Cardinal O'Hara 42-6 to improve to 2-0.

The Crusaders have not out-scored two opponents 102-6 through two games. Canisius beat Lockport 60-6 in the season opener.

"I have a lot of respect for those two programs for taking the games," Canisius coach Rich Robbins said. "But they really can't tell anyone how good we are."

Robbins said that both teams came into the game undermanned.

"O'Hara is a small school and they are very young," Robbins said. "They started a bunch of freshman and sophomores. Lockport has had a ton of injuries. Lockport's two best players are going to miss the season with injuries."

Still, when the NY State Rankings came out earlier this week, Canisius was sitting at #2 in Class AA, behind Rochester's Pittsford.

"It's been nice to get some of our younger kids some playing time," Robbins said, "and get them acclimated to varsity football. But we'll see how good we are starting this week."

Defending NYS champion Aquinas is coming to Buffalo this weekend.

"Everyone knows what's on the line when we get together," Robbins said. "They are a top program in this state. They've won a lot of titles and they have a long history of success."

Aquinas lost their season opener to Victor.

"They'll be coming in a little angry," Robbins said. "Last year, their team was loaded with Division I players and

college talent. This year, I think they have a few young guys getting experience but that doesn't matter with Aquinas. Their program is set up to re-load every year."

The last two meetings between the teams determined which program finished ranked #1 in the state.

"They are a really good football team and they will be ready to play," Robbins said. "We get everybody's best shot and it will be no different this weekend."

After the Aquinas game, Canisius will have dates with defending league champion St. Francis, arch-rival St. Joe's, in Ohio against Cardinal Mooney and in Pennsylvania against Erie Cathedral Prep.

"That's not easy," Robbins said. "Erie Prep is really, *really* good this year. If we are going to get where we want to go this year, it starts with Aquinas."

If Canisius is going to get back to the NYS Catholic Championship game, they will be riding senior Cole Burniston, who rushed 10 times for 71 yards and 2 TDs in the win over Cardinal O'Hara. Burniston also made 6 tackles and returned a fumble 69 yards for a TD.

"He had a pretty good day," Robbins said. "Cole is a great player but he's also a great student and a phenomenal kid. He's definitely the type of kid we want here."

Burniston (6-3, 225) ran a 4.51 in the 40-yard dash at Phio State earlier this summer.

"When you are that big and that fast, it can create a lot of matchup problems for our opponents," Robbins said.

Burniston, from Grimsby Ontario, is another Canadian

player who followed Mercer Timmis and Ryan Hunter over the border into Buffalo. Timmis is now playing for the Hamilton TigerCats in the CFL and Hunter is starting at Bowling Green.

"He knew of Mercer and Ryan," Robbins said. "He knew they had done well here and he looked us up on the internet. When his parents called us in March of 2015, we were very excited about the opportunity to have Cole come here."

Robbins was immediately impressed with Burniston.

"The first time I met him in person I was excited," Robbins said. "He's a big, strong kid and he certainly passed the eye test. But as impressive as he was, I was more impressed with the way he looked you in the eye and talked about his plans for the future."

Burniston, who maintains an academic average in high 80s, has been named a team captain for Canisius.

"He has just showed great leadership and attitude," Robbins said. "He's excited about coming to practice every day and that has rubbed off on his teammates."

Despite all this, Burniston may just now be coming into his own. He did not have the type of season in 2015 that many thought he would.

"He played football in Canada all summer," Robbins said. "He played 12 games for his team in Canada and then played with us. He had no time off and it definitely had an effect on him."

Burniston played in his team's Provincial championship game on Saturday, August 16th. He started training camp with Canisius two days later.

"He's 100 percent healthy this year," Robbins said, "and he can just focus on Canisius football."

Burniston says that, last year, he was worn down by the end of the Crusaders season.

"It wasn't easy," he said. "By the end of the season, I felt battered and bruised. My body was pretty fatigued."

After the season, Burniston rested - and got ready for the 2016 campaign.

"I started lifting in the winter," he said, "and in the spring I ran for the track team. I just wanted to get faster."

Robbins says that Burniston will also play TE and MLB at times this season.

"We didn't want him to play both ways last year," Robbins said. "I didn't think he could do that after playing in Canada all summer. But this year, I want to get him some film at linebacker and tight end. I think colleges are looking at him for those spots instead of running back."

Burniston has a scholarship offer from Division I-AA Wagner, but he is also receiving interest from Syracuse, Buffalo, Pittsburgh and Boston College.

"Playing college football has been a big dream of mine," Burniston said. "I've always followed college football and the NFL."

But, right now, Burniston has just one dream.

"Last year, we were all hoping to win the state championship and we fell short," he said. "This year, everybody's on the same page and has the same mind set. We want to win the state championship."
